



Problem & Impact

Thousands of Ukrainians on the de-occupied territories have nowhere to return. More than 150 000 private houses were destroyed due to russian invasion.

Families have to evacuate in other regions and countries, ask strangers for temporary stay, or live in terrible conditions: without heating, water supply, and other basic facilities.

By providing families with stable temporary housing on their property right now, we help decrease the level of forced emigration from de-occupied villages, impact the local economy and agriculture, save social connections and regional cultural uniqueness.




NEST * Mission

NEST mission is to join the prompt and coherent recovery of the de-occupied Ukrainian countryside by providing a prefabricated temporary house for families whose homes were destroyed due to the Russian war in Ukraine.

To help the community return to its life as much as possible, we have to help its citizens return home first.





A modular house

Ready-to-live: fully equipped and furnished

Connection to the engineering networks needed only

100% free for family, the house is transferred to their full ownership.

Basic house price 15 000 \$ (kitchen, bedroom, bathroom)

Flexible house construction to fit family size (extra bedrooms)

Year-round living conditions

term of production and assembly: 4-5 weeks





Community-level impact

We work with one community at a time to ensure the impact on its recovery and economy. We cooperate with local government to receive verified database of families who have returned or who would like to return to the community but their house, according to the assessment of an expert commission, can only be demolished. Local government can also assist with clearing the ruins or connecting communications if needed.

The NEST team works with community's database as list of candidates to receive a prefabricated house. We conduct personal meetings with each family submitted by the Community authorities and conduct an interview, which is later published as family's story, an additional stage of validation of candidates and their need of temporary housing on their property. The projects aims to help all families who do not have the financial or physical ability to help themselves with the restoration of their house at the moment.

How do families receive a house?

When we have enough money to start contracting the houses, we get in touch with a previously verified family to double check whether they still haven't received a housing from the government or other project & whether they approve the purchase of house for them.

When house is installed, we conduct a tripartite agreement between the Foundation, Contractor and family representer. The family representer signs the the act of acceptance-transfer of the house and they become its owners. No one can take away the house from family, but after family rebuilds - they can gift the NEST to other family in need.
